Dwyane Wade "Live to Dream" Summer Reading Program

The goal of the Wade program is to prevent the "summer slide" in reading achievement that children who are growing up in low-income circumstances often experience. Three summers of data reveal that the program is not only meeting, but is also exceeding, this goal: 48.8% of children have maintained their reading level across the summer, and 51.1% have increased their level. Moreover, comparisons of pre-and post-program scores on multiple assessments show significant gains in the ability to recognize words and read with comprehension. Particularly impressive is the significant gain in Gates-MacGinite Reading Test scores. The Gates-MacGinitie is a standardized test typically given at longer intervals than the five weeks of the Wade program. A significant gain after only five weeks of instruction is tremendous.
