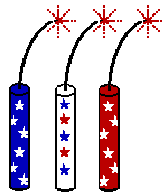
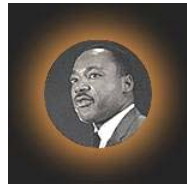

Father Marquette Returns to Campus



On Thursday, May 26, an artist from New York was commissioned by the University to create a sculpture of Pere Marquette for campus. On Friday, September 23, Pere Marquette made his return to Marquette.

The Pere Marquette sculpture was installed east of the Joan of Arc Chapel as a culmination of a two-year process of selecting the appropriate artist and creating the statue.

Mr. Ron Knepper, the artist of the Pere Marquette sculpture, is an accomplished sculptor and painter, and works out of his studio in New York. Mr. Knepper, also, is an Adjunct Instructor at the Parsons School of Design in New York City.

Mr. Knepper received his Bachelor's of Fine Arts in Sculpture, Drawing & Art History in 1982 from Indiana University in Fort Wayne, Indiana; his Master's of Art in Sculpture & Western Art History in 1984 from New Mexico State University in Las Cruces, New Mexico; and his Master's of Fine Arts in Sculpture & Printmaking in 1987 from Mills College in Oakland, California.
