On Thursday, December 14, Bob Koster, Field Construction Manager in Facilities Planning, Design and Construction, passed away after battling with cancer. Bob was 72 years old.

Bob was one of the most visible guys on campus. Never without his hard hat and always eager to chat and ask "how are you doing?"

Bob was a 1957 graduate of Marquette and was a 40-year employee of the University. He also was a dedicated member of Gesu Parish.

Bob loved his family...his wife, Jeanne; his sons, Robert and Christopher; and, his grand-daughter, Skyler. Bob enjoyed relaying all of Christopher's accomplishments and, you could tell, was very proud of him.

On campus, Bob knew how to "get the job done." It's going to be hard to get used to a campus without him. He interacted with so many departments and people.

THREE OF ADMINISTRATION'S OWN ARE HONORED

At the yearly Excellence in University Service Award presentation, which was held on Tuesday, April 17, three members of Administration were honored for their contributions to the University and for exemplifying Marquette's mission of excellence, faith, leadership and service.

Michele Adler, Office Coordinator for Public Safety, received one of the support staff awards. Michele is a vital member of the Public Safety staff. Quoting one nominator, "*Her title does not reflect the amount of responsibility she undertakes each day.*" In addition to maintaining systems related to building security, Michele also is responsible for payroll, personnel, purchasing, as well as many other duties for the Department of Public Safety.

Janet Gottfreid, Project Coordinator for Facilities Planning, Design and Construction, received one of the administrator awards. Throughout her career, Janet has worked in various areas of the University, and she has taught one nominator "*how to be a good mentor*". Janet has a 'can do' attitude and a desire "*to make the alum, donor or friend happy and important.*" From the Pere Marquette sculpture to the Stollenwerk walkway, Janet's excellence in service to the University is evident.

Paul Jablonski, Captain/Associate Director for Public Safety, received the other administrator award, posthumously. Before Paul's death on October 1, 2006, he played an integral role in the development of the University's Critical Incident Management Plan, as well as the Command Information Center within Public Safety, and was key in the revitalization of the Avenues West Police Substation. As stated by one of Paul's nominators, "*It would not be an overstatement to say that Paul has left an indelible mark on Marquette University.*"
