### **INTERNSHIP 3987 COURSE STRUCTURE (Full-Time Work)**

Why a 0-credit course?

- The 0-credit course is helpful to students who wish to work full time during a fall or spring semester and will take a semester away from classes to do so. It holds your full-time status as a Marquette University student and requires students to complete 400 work hours and course assignments.
- The student will NOT be charged tuition or student fees (as a result will not have access to the Student Medial Clinic or the PASS program and may not enroll in any MU courses beyond the internship).
- Completed in the Fall or Spring Semesters.
