

# TOP 12 REASONS WHY YOUR FINANCIAL AID IS NOT APPEARING ON YOUR BILL

## o Are you fully registered?

The aid on your bill reflects your current registration status:

- Undergraduates expecting MU Scholarships or Grants must be enrolled full-time (12 or more credits). Co-op grading period credit does not count towards full-time enrollment.
- MU Institutional Loans also require full-time enrollment.
- Federal Direct Loans or PLUS Loans require at least half-time enrollment (Undergraduate: 6 or more credits; Graduate: 4 or more; Professional: 6 or more).

### o Have you accepted your aid on CheckMarq?

 Direct subsidized and unsubsidized loans and MU Institutional Loans must be accepted every year.

## o Has your parent applied the Parent PLUS Loan?

- Parents of dependent undergraduate students can apply for the Parent PLUS loan online at studentaid.gov/plusapp.
- A new application must be submitted for every new PLUS loan.

## o Are your Loan Promissory Note(s) complete?

- Direct Loan Master Promissory Notes are completed at <u>studentaid.gov/mpn</u>.
- Instructions for completing the Promissory Note for a MU Institutional Loan are emailed to the student's <u>Marquette email account</u>.
- Parent borrowers are required to complete a Master Promissory Note for each student they borrow PLUS loans for at <u>studentaid.gov/mpn</u>.
- o Have you completed Federal Direct Loan Entrance Counseling?
  - All first-time borrowers of subsidized and unsubsidized loans are required to complete Entrance Counseling.
  - Entrance Counseling is completed at <u>studentaid.gov/entrancecounseling</u>
- o Have you completed your loan <u>Self-Certification</u> form?
  - The federal government requires Self-Certification be completed for all HHS, private and institutional loan programs.

### o Have you applied for a Grad/Professional Plus Loan?

- Graduate and Professional students can apply for a Grad PLUS loan online at studentaid.gov/plusapp.
- A new application must be submitted for every new PLUS loan.
- o Have you completed Grad/Prof PLUS Loan Entrance Counseling?
  - The Federal Government requires entrance and exit counseling for this loan.
    - Entrance Counseling is completed at <u>studentaid.gov/entrancecounseling</u>
- o Are there "To Do List" items on CheckMarq?
  - Log into CheckMarq to ensure that you have no outstanding To Do items.
  - Follow instructions to complete and submit any missing items.
- Do you have a "<u>Hold</u>"?
  - Log into CheckMarq to check for holds.
- o Are you meeting <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u>?
- Are you expecting Federal Work Study or Student Employment on your bill?
  - <u>Employment awards will not appear on your bill</u>; a biweekly paycheck is received when you work.
