This award, instituted during the University's Centennial year, is named in memory of Dr. Hugo Hellman, Dean of the College of Speech from 1941 through 1969. The award is presented to a full-time student majoring in Communication Studies or with a Teaching Major in Communication Studies.

Recipients must be completing their junior year and have excelled in scholarship and service to the University.

AWARD

Financial award totaling approximately \$8,000 will be distributed to one or more deserving students.
