



## **Scripps Howard Foundation Semester in Washington Program Fall 2008**

Juniors and seniors who are studying journalism are invited to apply for the fall 2008 Semester in Washington Program. Interns spend 14 weeks working as reporters for the Scripps Howard Foundation Wire. Interns earn a \$2,350 stipend and live rent-free in furnished apartments. Interns also participate in weekly seminars and tour Washington journalism and governmental institutions.

The interns' stories are published on our Web-based wire: [www.shfwire.com](http://www.shfwire.com). Some of their stories may go to news organizations we work with or the Scripps Howard News Service and its 400 client newspapers. Interns may write for hometown or campus newspapers and get internship or independent study credit.

The program is open to college juniors and seniors who have print or online experience. It is not open to graduates or graduate students. Applicants should have a previous internship or significant experience on a college newspaper or Web site. Applicants must also submit five clips, an essay and recommendations. Details are on the application form, which can be downloaded from our Web site.

### **Application postmark deadline for the fall 2008 term is March 21.**

The fall term starts Sept. 8 and runs to Dec. 12.

Dates and application deadlines for the 2009 spring, summer and fall programs will be posted on the Web site by late August.
