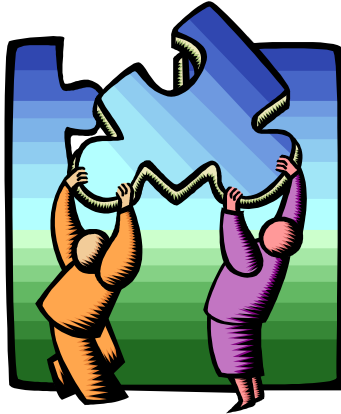


STRUGGLING TO MAKE ALL THE PIECES FIT?



Consider joining us for a Career Exploration Workshop

The Counseling Center offers both career exploration workshops and groups for students who are interested in learning strategies for choosing a major or a career path. Workshops are offered as brief, one-time events focusing on various career exploration topics, while groups meet for a small number of sessions and will usually cover a number of topics which are centered on career exploration. Both types of services give students an opportunity to meet with other students and to share ideas about their career decision-making experiences. Workshops and groups are offered each fall and spring semester. Workshops can be requested by student organizations and university faculty and staff.
