

## **Student Employee dress code**

Discretion and good judgment on the part of student employees in their style of dress and personal appearance are essential to the professional image and the safe operation of the university. Student workers are expected to dress in a professional manner appropriate to their working environment and to the type of work performed. Whatever your work setting, you must wear presentable clothing that is clean and not wrinkled. There may be additional clothing requirements depending on your specific job.

Appropriate attire:

- Dresses, skirts, jumper of appropriate length for a University office
- Solid color denim jeans (if clean and without rips, fraying, holes, etc.)
- Blouses, shirts, sweaters, polo-style shirts
- Any type of business shoe, sandals, boots and athletic shoes
- Message t-shirts with MU-messaging, please use your good judgement about what other message t-shirts are appropriate in a work environment.

Clothing that is revealing or inappropriate to the workplace is unacceptable. Inappropriate dress for student workers may include the following:

- Torn clothing
- Tank tops (unless fully covered by outer clothing), crop tops, halter tops, backless or bare shoulder or bare torso tops
- Gym shorts or extremely short shorts

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
