# APPLICATION

For Pre-Law Scholars program

Marquette University's Pre-Law Scholars Program allows students to receive the benefits of Marquette's distinctive liberal arts and sciences education while enjoying conditional admission to the university's law school.

Pre-Law Scholars complete a bachelor's degree and law degree in only six years, rather than the seven years normally required. Pre-Law Scholars complete the undergraduate part of their studies in three years and are awarded a bachelor's degree upon successful completion of their first year in the Law School.

Each year, Marquette University will enroll up to 25 students in the Pre-Law Scholars program. By fulfilling the conditions to remain in the program, Pre-Law Scholars will be admitted to the Marquette University Law School by the end of the junior year.

## Requirements:

- High school rank at or near the top 10 percent (when applicable)
- ACT composite score of 28 or SAT combined score of 1250 (math and verbal)
- Students must enroll in the Klingler College of Arts and Sciences, the College of Business Administration or the Diederich College of Communication
