You and your family are invited to Marquette for a two-for-one deal: **Learn more about the Helen Way Klingler College of Arts and Sciences and compete for a scholarship while you're on campus.**

Marquette's Klingler College is sponsoring an open house and scholarship competition on Saturday, Feb. 11, 2017. Join us for the competition, open house activities and campus tours. You'll find event details and a schedule online at marquette.edu/explore.

Scholarship competition

During the scholarship portion of the event, each prospective Klingler College student will have the opportunity to take an exam in one of the following subject areas **regardless of intended major**. There is nothing to study for the exams. We'll only ask you questions we think a high school senior should know. Times, locations and examination content areas are subject to change. Any changes will be reflected on the registration website.

Exam options: (CHOOSE ONE)

- **Biology:** This comprehensive examination covers topics of introductory college biology.
- **Chemistry:** This comprehensive examination covers topics of standard secondary school chemistry. Scientific calculators are allowed, but no graphing calculators or any calculator that allows the storage of formulas is allowed.
- **English:** This essay examination covers prose and poetry.
- **Foreign Language:** (French, German, Latin or Spanish) A substantial part of the test involves listening comprehension when applicable. Students will listen to statements and respond on an answer sheet. The other part is a written multiple-choice test.
Note: You are not eligible if you are a native speaker (or equivalent) in the language tested. The Latin exam does not include a listening comprehension section.
- **U.S. History:** This two-part examination is composed of 100 multiple-choice questions and three essay questions. Material will include U.S. history from 1607–1977.
- **Mathematics:** This examination is composed of multiple-choice questions and problem-solving, covering standard secondary school math subject matter through precalculus. Calculators are not permitted.
- **Physics:** This multiple-choice exam covers topics in introductory physics, including mechanics and elementary thermodynamics. You will need a calculator.



Selection and award information

The Klingler College of Arts and Sciences will offer 25 scholarships based on exam performance. The amount of each award is \$20,000 over four years, or \$2,500 per semester up to eight semesters.

- The Klingler College scholarship competition exams are offered only on the Marquette campus on Saturday, Feb. 11, 2017. Given the nature of the examinations, absolutely no alternate dates are permitted.
- Winners are selected based entirely on exam performance.

Event schedule

Event schedules are posted at marquette.edu/explore. Events are offered for parents during the exam portion of the day. The day will last from 9 a.m. through the early afternoon. On-campus parking and location information will be shared upon registration.
