### Job Description:

The student caller position is available for current Marquette students. Student callers contact alumni and friends of Marquette to keep them in touch with the University and raise money to support such things as student and athletic scholarships, teaching excellence, and technology advancements.

A student caller position is a great way to develop communication skills, add experience to your resume, and meet new students. The Phonathon is located on campus and runs shifts Sunday 1:00–5:00pm and Sunday through Thursday 5:30–9:30pm.

Student callers work a minimum of 8 hours a week (two 4 hour shifts). Starting wage is **\$8.50/hour** with bi-weekly bonus opportunities. The Marquette Phonathon is committed to offering one of the most competitive wage rates on Marquette campus.
