There are many different approaches to sex education and we should continue to explore these options.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We make alcohol education mandatory, but sexual education is not. Is a Sex Edu. a feasible option?</li> <li>• We are a Jesuit university, and this fact complicates the nature of sex education on campus. Most of the information students receive about sex is from their peers or the internet.</li> <li>• “No Questions Asked” - Would having an anonymous STD screening be a beneficial service at SHS?</li> <li>• Clinics close to campus offer free STD screening. Would outsourcing sexual health services be beneficial for Marquette?</li> </ul>
