4. Survey Results (Brice)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 246 people complete the survey. 52% were aware that they paid a student health fee. Average increase supported was about \$7.50. 	<p><u>Brice:</u> Send comments to the board.</p> <p><u>ALL:</u> Review the survey results and be ready to action next semester.</p>

Dr. Smith’s Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dr. Smith reviewed the budget information presented at the first meeting. 86% of students have only visited SHS 1 or 2 times in this fiscal year. Therefore, charging students who visit more often a higher fee would not be beneficial. 668 new patients were seen in the summer, and charging these patients would bring in a large sum of money. As for adjusting the hours that SHS is open, they have been adjusted to reflect times when most students visited in the past. 	<p><u>ALL:</u> Brainstorm ideas for educating the student body about sexual health and SHS services.</p>

Is the benefit of cutting charges worth losing the revenue regarding STI testing? • Katie suggested that SHAB help promote the sexual health services offered by SHS. • Dr. Smith recommended brainstorming ways to reach a larger audience for sexual health presentations and promoting SHS services. She also suggested forming a subcommittee for making our website more user-friendly. • One possibility for educating the student body about sexual health/wellness is a program similar to Alcohol Edu.
