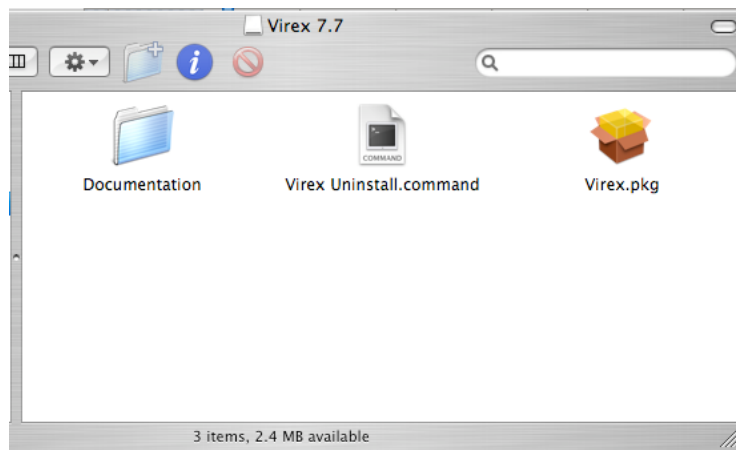

## Virex 7.7 Installation

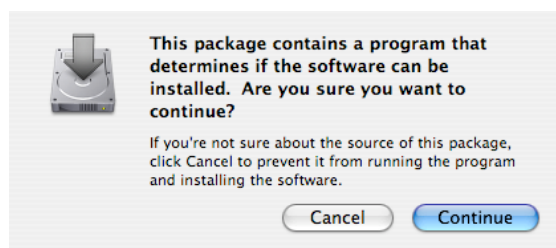
This version of Virex is compatible with Mac OS X version 10.2.6 through 10.4+. If you are using an older version of Mac OS X or using a newer Intel-based Macintosh, please contact the IT Services Help Desk for assistance.

1. If you have not done so already, log into to CheckMarq at <https://checkmarq.mu.edu/> and browse to the Campus Downloads page (found in the **Link Menu** section of your CheckMarq portal page).
2. Click on the link to download Virex 7.7.
3. An installer window similar to the one pictured here should appear.

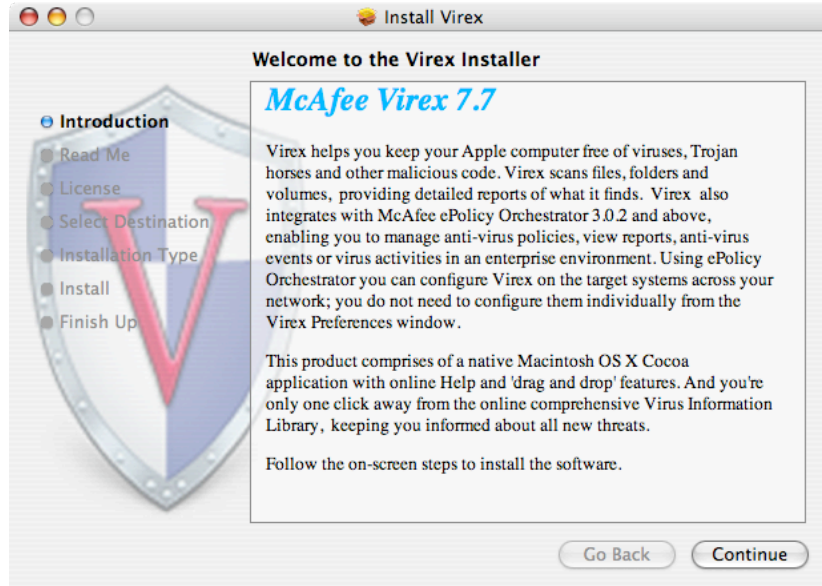


If you do not see this window, locate the file **Virex 7.7.dmg** that you downloaded in Step 2 above. Double-click the file to reveal the installer window.

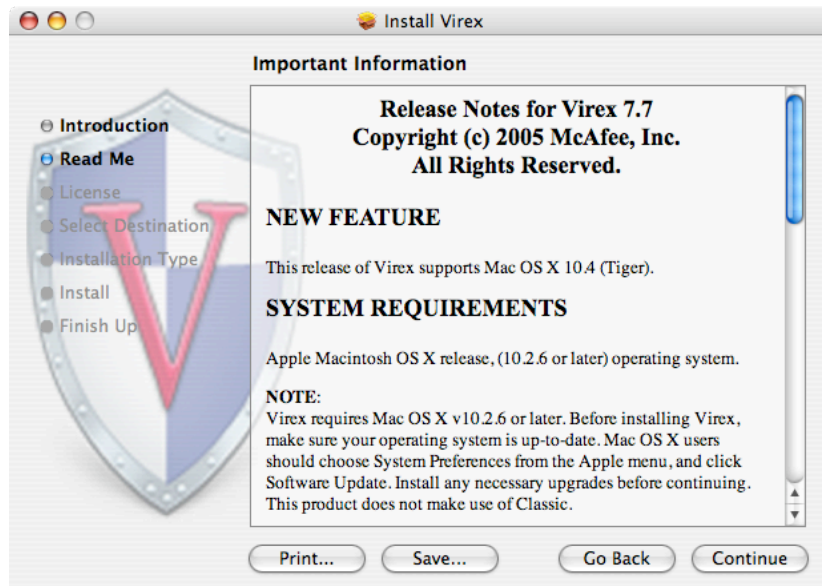
4. To begin installation, double-click on **Virex.pkg**. When presented with the following screen, click **Continue**.



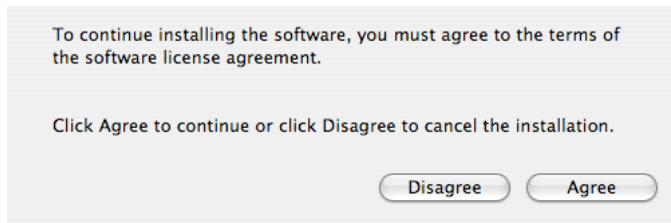
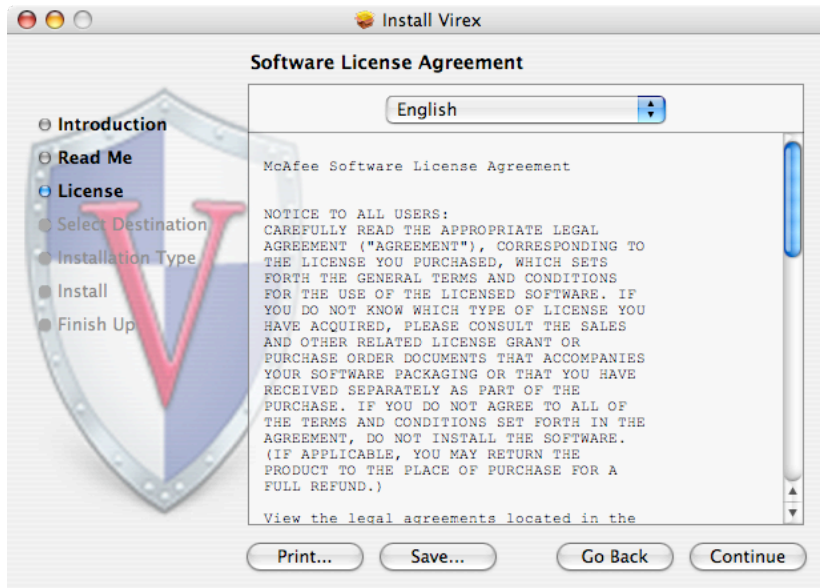
5. Click **Continue** on the installer welcome screen.



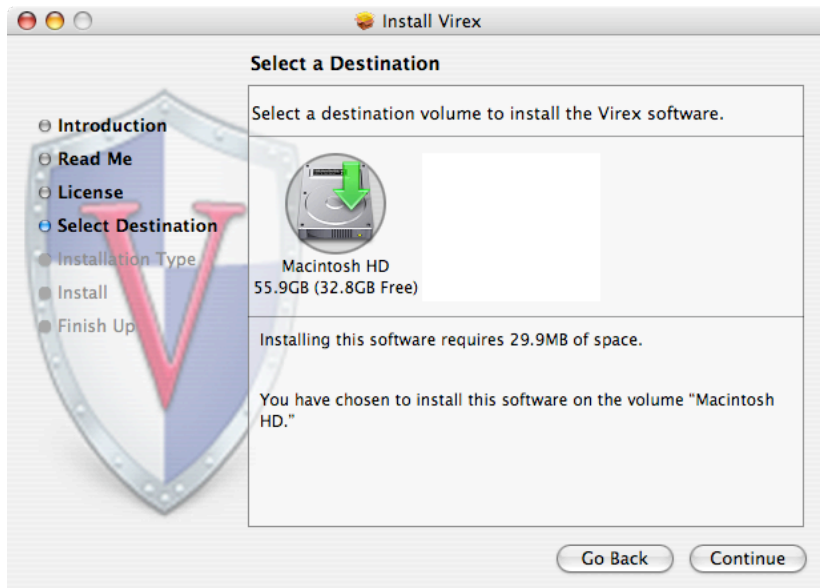
6. Review the Virex 7.7 release notes and then click **Continue**.



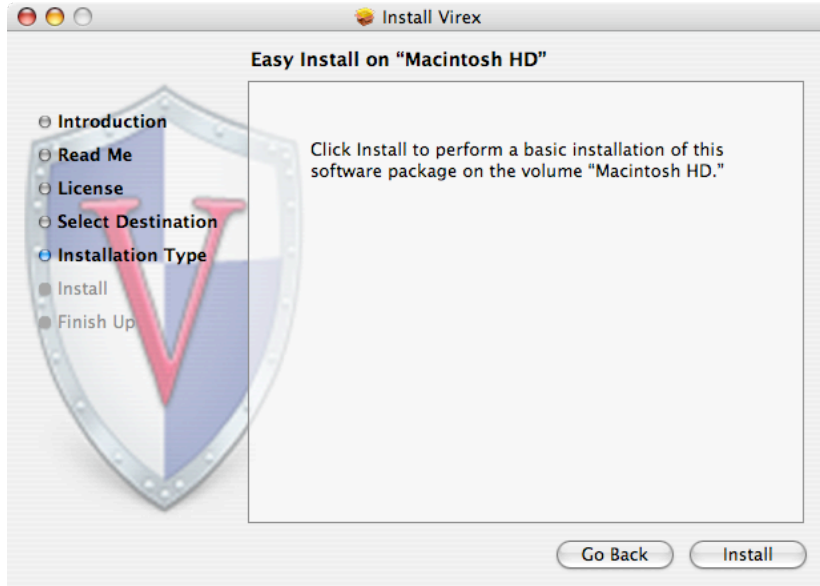
7. Click **Continue** and then **Agree** on the following two windows to continue installations.



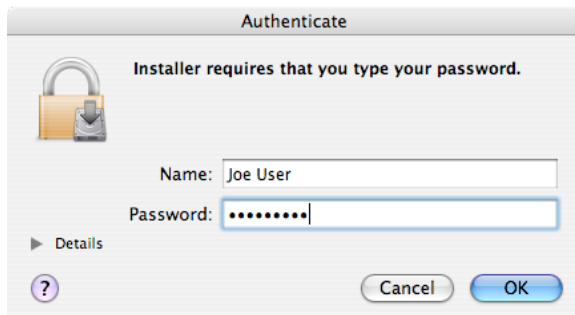
8. Make sure your primary hard drive is selected and then click **Continue**.



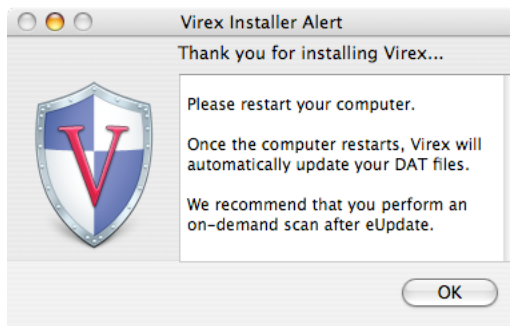
9. Click **Install** to continue.



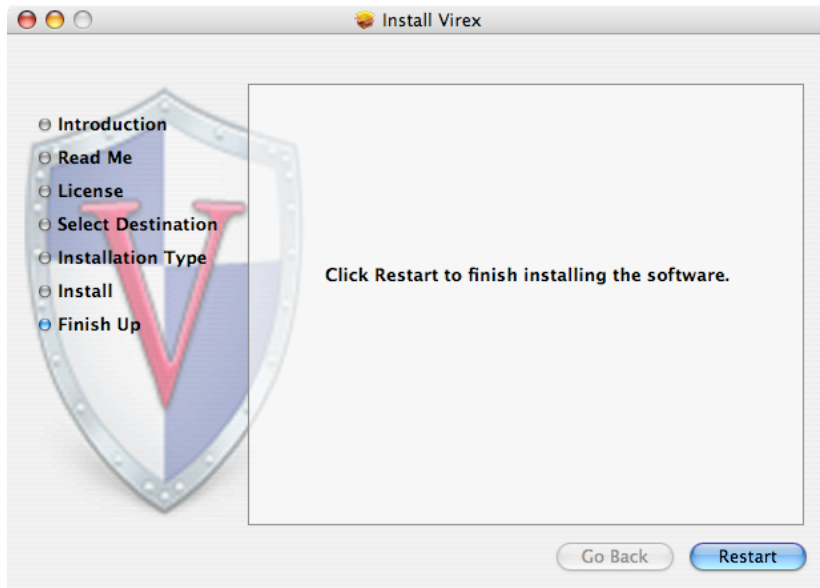
10. You will be prompted to authenticate. The **Name** field should already be filled you're your Mac login name. Enter the **Password** that you use to log you're your Mac. The password is the same as that which was used when you initially set up your computer. Click **OK** once you have entered your password.



11. After the installation is completed, you will be presented with an alert. Click **OK** to dismiss this window.



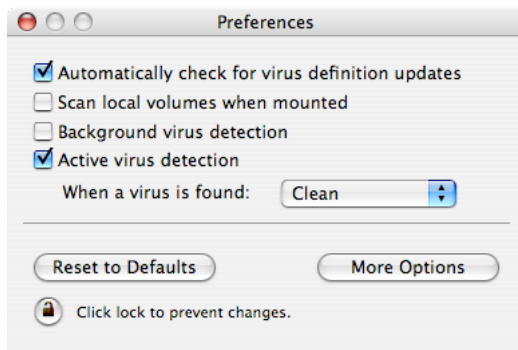
12. Click **Restart** to complete the installation. After rebooting, return to this installation guide to properly configure Virex.



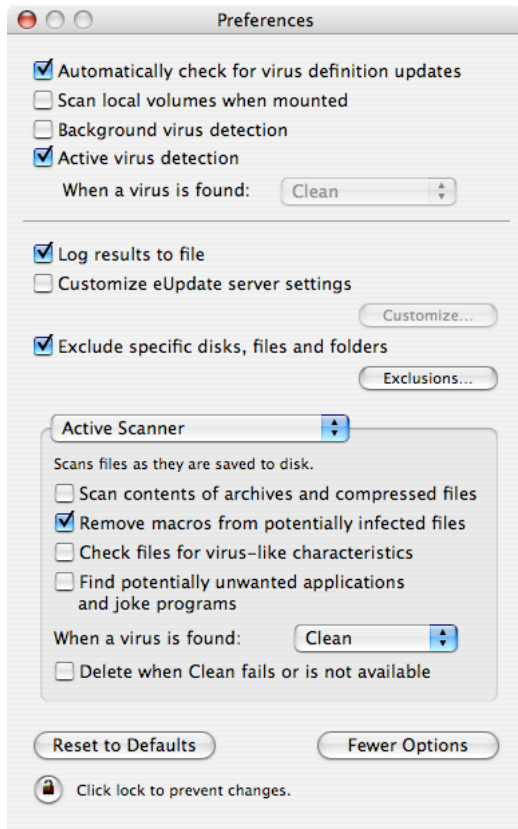
13. After restarting your computer, Virex will automatically launch and begin downloading updated virus definition files.



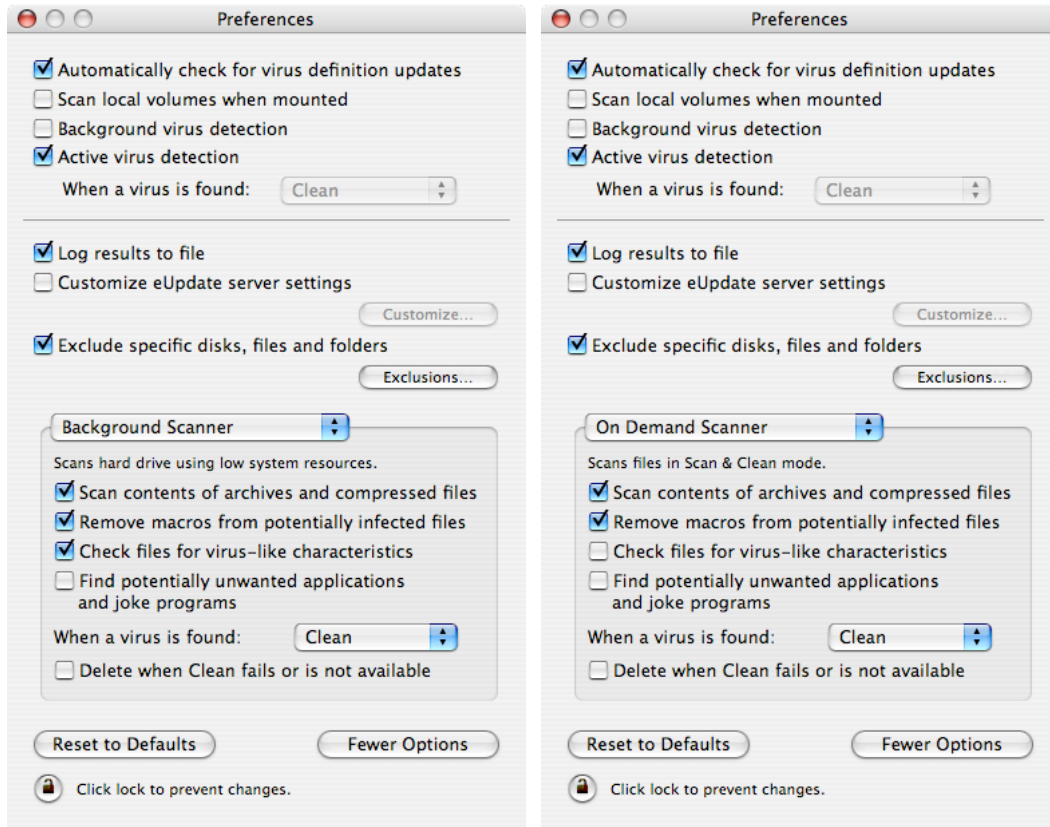
14. Configure Virex by clicking on the **Preferences** icon. You may do this now even if Virex is still in the process of downloading updates. The following window should appear.



15. Click on the **More Options** button to reveal a window that looks like the one below.



16. Enable the option, as shown, to **Remove macros from potentially infected files**. Repeat this configuration for each of the following windows for **Background Scanner** and **On Demand Scanner**.



You can close the Preferences window by clicking on the **Red** button (widget) in the upper left corner of the window. You may quit Virex if it has completed updating the definition files.

**Virex installation and configuration is now complete.**
