IT ALL BEGAN 150 YEARS AGO. THE MAKING OF A GREAT AMERICAN SUCCESS STORY THAT TODAY INSPIRES A PEOPLE AND DRIVES A NATION.

BORN THIS DAY IN 1848 WAS A GLORIOUS LAND NESTLED BETWEEN THE NATION'S TWO GREATEST LAKES AND ITS MIGHTIEST RIVER. A LAND SETTLED BY STRONG AND BOLD PEOPLE, RESOLUTE IN THEIR VISION FOR THE FUTURE AND DETERMINED TO MAKE THEIR EVERY ENDEAVOR A SUCCESS.

BORN THIS DAY WAS A PLACE CALLED WISCONSIN, THE 30TH STATE IN AMERICA. LITTLE DID THE NATION KNOW THE GREATNESS ABOUT TO BE UNLEASHED.

WISCONSIN IS 150 YEARS OF UNWAVERING COMMITMENT TO FREEDOM AND OPPORTUNITY.

THE EAGLE MASCOT OLD ABE SOARS THROUGH HISTORY WITH THE FURY AND MIGHT OF WISCONSIN'S IRON BRIGADE THAT PRESERVED THE UNION. WE INHERIT THE BRAVERY OF THE 32ND "RED ARROW" DIVISION – ONE OF THE MOST DECORATED DIVISIONS IN MILITARY HISTORY -- AND THE DEDICATION TO SERVICE OF A LATER GENERATION IN VIETNAM.

WE HONOR THE MODEST OLD STRUCTURES THAT SERVED AS WAY-STATIONS TO FREEDOM ON THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD. WE TAKE PRIDE IN BEING THE FIRST STATE TO STRIKE DOWN THE FUGITIVE SLAVE LAW, INSTITUTE ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS AND SECURE A WOMAN'S RIGHT TO VOTE.

WISCONSIN IS 150 YEARS OF INNOVATION AND THE PURSUIT OF EXCELLENCE.

FROM THE SHINING BROW OF FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT POURED NEW WAYS OF HARMONIZING NATURE AND HABITAT. THE PRACTICAL INVENTIVENESS OF CHRISTOPHER LATHAM SHOLES PRODUCED THE TYPEWRITER.
