AND FOR THIS AWARD. YOU DO WONDERFUL WORK
IN WASHINGTON GETTING STUDENTS FROM
WISCONSIN READY FOR PUBLIC SERVICE.

I'D ALSO LIKE TO THANK WISCONSIN ELECTRIC, AND CHAIRMAN DICK ABDOO IN PARTICULAR, FOR MAKING THIS EVENT HAPPEN TODAY.

YOUR SUPPORT FOR THE LES ASPIN CENTER IS HELPING PROVIDE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR DOZENS OF WISCONSIN STUDENTS TO HAVE THE CHANCE TO ENTER PUBLIC SERVICE.

I'D ALSO LIKE TO RECOGNIZE, AMONG OTHERS, MARQUETTE PRESIDENT FATHER ROBERT WILD, JOHN BURKE (Burke Properties), BILL DREW, AND ULICE PAYNE AND SHARON HAVERSTOCK FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF THE ASPIN CENTER.

THE ASPIN CENTER HAS ALWAYS BEEN IMPORTANT TO ME, BECAUSE I AM A BIG BELIEVER IN PUBLIC SERVICE. I BELIVE THAT THE GREEK WRITER HOMER WAS RIGHT MORE THAN 2,000 YEARS AGO WHEN HE SAID, "HE SERVES ME MOST, WHO SERVES HIS COUNTRY BEST."

THOSE WORDS COULD HAVE EASILY DESCRIBED LES ASPIN. LES ASPIN WAS A VERY POWERFUL PERSON IN WASHINGTON, SPENDING MORE THAN 20 YEARS IN CONGRESS AND 2 YEARS AS DEFENSE SECRETARY. YET, DESPITE HIS POWER, ASPIN USED HIS SENIORITY TO BENEFIT THE PUBLIC, NOT HIMSELF.

ASPIN WAS ALWAYS VERY RESPONSIVE TO WISCONSIN NEEDS, NOT HIS OWN. I REMEMBER WORKING WITH HIM VERY CLOSELY IN 1987 AFTER CHRYSLER ANNOUNCED IT WAS SHUTTING DOWN ITS PLANT IN KENOSHA.

WE WORKED TOGETHER TO MAKE SURE CHRYSLER EMPLOYEES RECEIVED A GOOD

SEVERANCE PACKAGE, AND WE MADE SURE CHRYSLER COMMITTED TO KEEP ITS ENGINE PLANT IN KENOSHA OPERATING.

THIS CRISIS HELPED US BUILD A GREAT WORKING RELATIONSHIP. IT WAS A RELATIONSHIP THAT WOULD SERVE WISCONSIN WELL FOR THE NEXT DECADE.

WE MAY HAVE COME FROM DIFFERENT POLITICAL PARTIES, BUT WE CAME FROM SIMILAR BACKGROUNDS. BOTH LES AND I CAME FROM WORKING CLASS BACKGROUNDS AND LEARNED THE IMPORTANCE OF HARD WORK.

THAT ALLOWED US TO PUT PARTISAN POLITICS ASIDE TO DO WHAT WAS RIGHT FOR THE STATE.

LES WAS SUCCESSFUL BECAUSE HE HAD A GREAT PERSONALITY.

HE WASN'T EGOTISTICAL. HE WASN'T PROUD. HE WASN'T ARROGANT. HE WAS THERE TO

REPRESENT THE PEOPLE OF HIS DISTRICT, AND DO WHAT HE COULD FOR WISCONSIN.

I BET THAT RIGHT NOW, LES IS LOOKING DOWN FROM HEAVEN SITTING NEXT TO HIS DOG JUNKET, AND SAYING "ENOUGH ABOUT ME, TALK ABOUT THE PROGRAM."

LES CARED DEEPLY ABOUT MAKING THIS PROGRAM A SUCCESS. HE'D BE PROUD TO SEE WHAT'S GOING ON WITH THE PROGRAM TODAY.

I HAVE SEEN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROGRAM OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS AS A MEMBER OF THE CENTER'S BOARD OF VISITORS. BUT LES DESERVES A LOT OF THE CREDIT FOR TRANSFORMING THIS CENTER INTO A FIRST-RATE ACADEMIC PROGRAM.

SINCE 1988, MORE THAN 700 STUDENTS HAVE STUDIED AT THE ASPIN CENTER IN WASHINGTON, ALONG WITH NEARLY 100 LEADERS FROM EASTERN AND WESTERN AFRICA.

IN ADDITION, NEARLY 50 MARQUETTE AND U-W STUDENTS HAVE PARTICIPATED IN ASPIN CENTER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS IN LONDON, ROME, ATHENS AND NAIROBI.

STUDENTS HAVE LEARNED ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF PUBLIC SERVICE BY INTERNING IN CONGRESSIONAL OFFICES, OR IN FEDERAL AGENCIES LIKE THE STATE DEPARTMENT AND THE SECRET SERVICE. THEY ALSO INTERN AT WISCONSIN CORPORATIONS AND SEE HOW THEY INTERACT WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

THOSE INTERNSHIPS HAVE TRULY PAID OFF.

NEARLY 50 GRADUATES OF ASPIN PROGRAMS NOW WORK AS PROFESSIONAL STAFF IN THE

UNITED STATES CONGRESS, INCLUDING THREE AS CHIEFS OF STAFF FOR HOUSE MEMBERS.

SEVERAL GRADUATES NOW HOLD PUBLIC OFFICE, INCLUDING PEDRO COLON, THE FIRST HISPANIC EVER ELECTED TO THE WISCONSIN STATE ASSEMBLY.

IT'S ALSO THE <u>ONLY</u> SCHOOL IN WISCONSIN TO HAVE A PROGRAM IN WASHINGTON D.C. A NUMBER OF SCHOOLS IN THE UW-SYSTEM, INCLUDING MADISON AND GREEN BAY, SEND STUDENTS OUT TO WASHINGTON TO WORK IN THE PROGRAM.

THIS PROGRAM IS JUST ONE OF MANY PROGRAMS THAT HAS MADE MARQUETTE UNIVERSITY A LEADER IN HIGHER EDUCATION. FOR MORE THAN 118 YEARS, THE UNIVERSITY HAS HELPED DEVELOP LEADERS WHO HAVE A DESIRE TO SERVE OTHERS.

IT HAS ALSO SHOWN A FINE TRADITION OF PLACING GRADUATES IN GOOD JOBS, WHETHER IN

POLITICS, PUBLIC SERVICE OR THE BUSINESS WORLD.

ALL OF THESE PROGRAMS HELP SET MARQUETTE APART AND HELP EXPLAIN WHY U-S NEWS AND WORLD REPORT HAS RANKED MARQUETTE AS ONE OF THE NATION'S BEST COLLEGE VALUES FOR THE PAST THREE YEARS.

BUT I AM MOST PROUD THAT MARQUETTE IS HELPING PRODUCE NEW LEADERS DEDICATED TO PUBLIC SERVICE. IN RECENT YEARS, DEVOTING YOURSELF TO A LIFE OF PUBLIC SERVICE HAS GOTTEN A BAD NAME. THE LES ASPIN CENTER IS HELPING CHANGE THAT PERCEPTION.

FOR EXAMPLE, A STUDENT WHO WENT THROUGH THE PROGRAM IN WASHINGTON SAYS HIS EXPERIENCE HELPED CHANGE HIS IMPRESSIONS OF POLITICANS.

HE SAID HIS EXPERIENCE AT THE LES ASPIN
CENTER "COMPLETELY CHANGED MY VIEW THAT

POLITICANS ARE CROOKS. MOST ARE DEDICATED WORKAHOLICS."

MY HOPE IS THAT LES'S DREAM OF TRAINING MORE YOUNG STUDENTS FOR PUBLIC SERVICE WILL CONTINUE TO GROW.

FORMER SENATOR WILLIAM BROCK OF TENNESSEE ONCE SAID "SOLUTIONS AREN'T GOING TO COME OUT OF WASHINGTON, BUT LEADERSHIP CAN."

I HOPE THAT THE WORK OF FATHER O'BRIEN AND THE TEACHERS AT THE LES ASPIN CENTER CONTINUES TO PRODUCE LEADERS WISCONSIN, AND AMERICA, CAN BE PROUD OF.
