BALD EAGLE, OSPREY, LOON AND THE GREAT BLUE HERON NEST HERE AND MIGRATING WATERFOWL USE IT AS A WELCOME FILLING STATION ON THE WAY NORTH AND SOUTH.

ONCE-ENDANGERED WOLF PACKS NOW ROAM THE NORTHWESTERN AND SOUTHERN PORTIONS OF THE FLOWAGE. AND DEER, BEAR, RACCOON, FISHER AND OTTER ALL CALL THE WILLOW FLOWAGE HOME AS WELL.
