THANK YOU, MARY (JORDAN), FOR THAT WARM INTRODUCTION ON THIS COLD AFTERNOON. I WANT TO THANK YOU AND YOUR FELLOW RESIDENTS IN THE NORTH CENTRAL COMMUNITY PLANNING COUNCIL FOR PROVIDING SUBSTANTIAL VISION ON HOW TO CREATE NEW HOUSING IN THIS NEIGHBORHOOD.

I AM VERY PLEASED TO BE HERE TODAY TO HELP CELEBRATE THE START OF SOMETHING BIG: LINDSAY HEIGHTS.

THIS COOPERATIVE EFFORT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE, THE STATE OF WISCONSIN AND THE NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (NIDC) WILL BRING HIGH-QUALITY, AFFORDABLE HOUSING TO

MILWAUKEE'S CENTRAL CITY.

HOME OWNERSHIP IS SO IMPORTANT FOR THE VITALITY OF ANY COMMUNITY. IT IS THE HANDSHAKE THAT BINDS PEOPLE TOGETHER AND BRINGS A SENSE OF COMMITMENT AND STABILITY TO SOCIETY. BUT THERE ARE VIRTUALLY NO NEW HOMES TO BUY IN MILWAUKEE'S CENTRAL CITY.

WE VALUE THE INTEGRITY OF THIS WONDERFUL COMMUNITY AND WE WANTED TO RESTORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR HOME OWNERSHIP RIGHT HERE IN THE CENTRAL CITY. WE DIDN'T WANT RESIDENTS TO HAVE TO LEAVE THEIR NEIGHBORHOODS TO REALIZE THE AMERICAN DREAM.

SO WE STUDIED THE SITUATION TO FIND OUT WHAT PEOPLE COULD AFFORD AND HOW WE COULD BUILD HOMES TO MEET THOSE NEEDS, AND LINDSAY HEIGHTS WAS BORN.

THERE ARE SOME 100 VACANT LOTS IN THE BLOCKS SURROUNDING THIS HOME, AND IT IS OUR GOAL TO HELP PUT AFFORDABLE HOUSING LIKE THIS ON ALL THOSE LOTS AND HELP HARD-WORKING CENTRAL CITY FAMILIES GET INTO THOSE HOMES.

LINDSAY HEIGHTS IS A GREAT MODEL FOR PARTNERSHIPS IN URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND IT IS A GREAT WIN FOR MY CENTRAL CITY INITIATIVE. AS JUANITA WILLIAMS AT THE CCI FOR JOB PLACEMENT PLACES CENTRAL CITY RESIDENTS IN GOOD PAYING JOBS ...

AND JOHN SCHULTZ AT THE CCI FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT HELPS CENTRAL CITY RESIDENTS START THEIR OWN BUSINESSES ... LINDSAY HEIGHTS WILL OFFER THEM THE CHANCE TO REACH THE AMERICAN DREAM OF HOME

OWNERSHIP.

IT HAS BEEN A MAJOR UNDERTAKING, AND I HAVE QUITE A LIST OF PEOPLE TO THANK, STARTING WITH FRITZ RUF, WHEDA'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

WHEDA INVESTED \$500,000 ON THE DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS TO THESE 100 PROPERTIES, HELPED COORDINATE ALL THE PARTIES, AND WHEDA WILL BE OFFERING THE 4% LOANS THAT WILL ENABLE FAMILIES TO REACH THE AMERICAN DREAM.

I WANT TO GIVE SPECIAL THANKS TO SOME IMPORTANT WHEDA STAFFERS: WYMAN WINSTON AND CONNIE PUKAITE (POO-KAY). FRITZ HANDED THEM THE BALL ON THIS PROJECT, AND THEY TOOK THE HANDOFF LIKE RON DAYNE AND

PLOWED IT INTO THE END ZONE. LET'S GIVE WYMAN AND CONNIE A BIG HAND.

I ALSO WANT TO THANK ANOTHER BIG PARTNER, MAYOR NORQUIST. MAYOR NORQUIST HAD A SPECIAL VISION OF THE HOME DESIGN NEEDED TO BLEND INTO THESE CENTRAL CITY COMMUNITIES, AND HIS OFFICE WORKED WITH ALL PARTNERS TO CUT THROUGH THE RED TAPE, SO WE COULD BE HERE TODAY TO CUT THE RIBBON.

I ALSO WANT TO RECOGNIZE LEO REESE AND JIM SAYERS OF THE NIDC. NIDC PERFORMED THE TIME-CONSUMING TASK OF OBTAINING PERMITS AND APPROVALS, NAILING DOWN THE ADMINISTRATIVE FRAMEWORK OF THIS HOUSING DEVELOPMENT. WE WOULDN'T BE HERE TODAY WITHOUT YOUR HARD WORK.

AND I WANT TO THANK MITCH WALDBERG OF NEW CENTURY HOMES OF MILWAUKEE, WHO DEVELOPED AND ASSEMBLED THESE HOMES. I WANT TO TELL YOU HOW IMPRESSED I AM WITH THE DESIGN AND QUALITY.

MITCH, I KNOW YOU AND YOUR CONTRACTORS WORKED DOUBLE-TIME THROUGH THE WEEKEND TO GET THESE HOMES READY FOR TODAY. SO JUST IN CASE YOU MISSED IT, THE BADGERS AND PACKERS BOTH WON.

THIS IS A WONDERFUL PARTNERSHIP AND I ENCOURAGE ALL OUR PARTNERS TO EXPAND THIS TYPE OF PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

I KNOW IT WOULD SUCCEED IN OTHER URBAN AREAS ACROSS WISCONSIN: FROM SUPERIOR TO KENOSHA, FROM EAU CLAIRE TO GREEN BAY . . . EVEN IN MY HOMETOWN OF ELROY.
