THANK YOU ALL FOR BEING HERE.

I'M GLAD TO BE ABLE TO BE HERE, TODAY. I CAN'T THINK OF A MORE FITTING PLACE TO SIGN THIS PIECE OF LEGISLATION THAN AT THE RED CABOOSE DAY CARE CENTER.

TODAY, AS THE NUMBER OF SINGLE PARENTS AND DUAL-CAREER COUPLES CONTINUES TO GROW, A PARENT'S BIGGEST WORRY IS FINDING AND AFFORDING QUALITY DAY CARE FOR HIS OR HER CHILDREN.

THERE IS A GROWING NEED ACROSS OUR STATE AND NATION FOR ACCESS TO SOLID, HIGH-QUALITY DAY CARE PROGRAMS.

SINCE 1987, FUNDING FOR CHILD CARE SERVICES HAS MORE THAN TRIPLED ...
