History: St. John by the Sea Church is a partially Indian parish.

1946-1973	Diocesan priests visited Klawock (Tlingit), Prince of Wales Island from St. Rose, Wrangell and St. Catherine's, Petersburg
1973-1976	A diocesan priest attended St. John by the Sea Mission from Holy Name, Ketchikan
1976-1979	A diocesan priest attended St. John's from St. Rose, Wrangell
1983-1988	Became a parish; a diocesan priest established and administered St. John by the Sea Church (Tlingit)
1988-2000	Oblates of Mary Immaculate (formerly Pacific; now United States Province, Washington, D.C.) administered St. John's
2000-present	Diocesan priests have administered St. John's
