| 1921-2000 | Jesuits established and administered St. Lawrence/St. Barbara Church (Eskimo) |
| 2000s-present | Diocesan priests have administered St. Lawrence/St. Barbara Church |

Jesuits and diocesan priests from St. Lawrence attended the following Eskimo missions:

| 1914-1965 (transferred to Church of Immaculate Heart of Mary, Marshall) | Pilot Station; attended alternately from St. Lawrence, Mountain Village; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Russian Mission; and Church of Mary, Marshall) |
| 1930-1970 (transferred to Immaculate Conception, Bethel) | Church of Mary, the Mother of God, Marshall |
| 1932-1960 | Tukchuk station |
| 1939-1950 (transferred to Immaculate Conception, Bethel) | St. Theresa Mission, Aniak |
| 1965-present | St. Charles Spinola Mission, Pilot Station; attended alternately from St. Lawrence, Mountain Village, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Russian Mission, and Church of Mary, Marshall |
