History:

ca. 1890-1943	Jesuits (formerly Turin, Canada, and California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) visited Bethel station (Eskimo) from Holy Cross, Holy Cross and St. Joseph's, Tununak
1943-present	Jesuits established and have administered Immaculate Conception Church (Eskimo); permanent deacons (Eskimo) have assisted since 1995

Jesuits from Immaculate Conception attended the following Eskimo missions:

1943-1968 (transferred to St. Theresa, Aniak)	Sacred Heart/ Immaculate Conception Mission, Kalskag
1950-1968 (became a parish)	St. Theresa Mission, Aniak
ca. 1970-1990 (became a parish)	Church of Mary, the Mother of God, Marshall
