History: Holy Family Church is a non-Indian parish that has had a few Pima, Tohono O'odham and/or Yaqui Indian parishioners.

1915-1957	Discalced Carmelites (Barcelona Province, Barcelona, Spain) established and administered Holy Family (Pima, Tohono O'odham and Yaqui)
1958-1964	Society of African Missions (American Province, Tenafly, New Jersey) administered Holy Family
1965-present	Diocesan priests have administered Holy Family

Various priests from Holy Family have attended the following Indian missions:

1938-1950 (becomes a parish)	St. Margaret Mary Mission (Pima, Tohono O'odham and/or Yaqui), Tucson; included a few American Indian parishioners
1930-present	Santa Rosa Mission (Yaqui), Tucson
