| 1927-1939 | Franciscans (St. John the Baptist Province, Cincinnati, Ohio) established and attended St. John the Evangelist/ Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha Mission (Navajo), Navajo Reservation, from St. Michael's, St. Michaels |
| 1934-1964 (closed) | Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and Colored People (Bensalem, Pennsylvania) established and staffed St. John the Evangelist/ Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha School (Navajo) |
| 1939-present | Became a parish; Franciscans have administered St. John the Evangelist Church |
