History:

1910-1916	Franciscans (St. John the Baptist Province, Cincinnati, Ohio) established and attended St. Isabel Church (Navajo), Navajo Reservation, from Annunciation, Chinle
1916-present	Franciscans (now Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, Albuquerque, New Mexico) have administered St. Isabel's

Franciscans from St. Isabel's have attended the following Navajo Indian missions and stations on the Navajo Reservation:

1940-present	Our Lady of Guadalupe Mission, Round Rock
1940-present	St. Ann Mission, Tsaile
1940-present	Our Lady of the Lake Mission, Wheatfields
1940-ca. 1970	Greasewood station (transferred to St. Anne's, Klagetoh)
1940-ca. 1980	Wind Lake station
1940-ca. 1980	Crane's Neck station
1940-1990	Rock Point station
1950-1990	Black Rock station
