History: The Redemptorists' Denver Province was established in 1996 with the merger of the Oakland (Oakland, California) and St. Louis Provinces (St. Louis, Missouri). The St. Louis Province had administered the following Indian missions and parishes:

1830-1838	St. John the Evangelist Church (Menominee), Green Bay, Wisconsin
1833-1836 (transferred to diocesan priests)	Holy Childhood of Jesus/ St. Peter Church (Ojibwa and Ottawa), Harbor Springs, Michigan
1834-1838 (transferred to diocesan priests)	Holy Name of Mary Church (Ojibwa), Sault Sainte Marie, Michigan
1922-1931 (transferred to Franciscans)	San José y San Miguel Mission (Mestizos) San Antonio, Texas; many parishioners of Indian descent

Description: The correspondence, house chronicles, photographs, and personnel files within the St. Louis Province records are believed to include some references to Native Catholic evangelization.
