Description: Correspondence, photographs, scrapbooks (volumes 1, 3, and 5, biographical sketch, clippings, post cards, 1920s-1940s), and visitors' register collected by Harry Webb Marsh (1886-1964); re: St. Joseph's and Sacred Heart Missions, Culdesac (Slickpoo) and Cataldo, Idaho, respectively; Our Lady of Sorrows Mission (Kalispel), Cusick, Washington; Reverend Joseph Joset, S.J., Reverend Nicholas Point, S.J., and Jesuits; Chief Gary (Spokane) and Spokane Indians; and Chief Seltice (Coeur d'Alene) and Coeur d'Alene Indians; bulk of correspondence spans from 1930-1955.
