History: The Canons Regular of the Order of the Holy Cross, also known as the Congregation of the Holy Cross or Crozier Fathers, are believed to have been founded by Theodore of Celles about 1210. Their Midwest (Notre Dame, Indiana) and Southern Provinces (Austin, Texas) have included Indian ministries in the United States, 1990-present.

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans in the United States are unknown.
