History: Saint Eugene de Mazenod founded the Oblates of Mary Immaculate in France in 1816. The Oblates of Mary Immaculate made their first U.S. foundation in 1842 with the following provinces administering Indian missions and evangelization in the United States:

1861-1865	Saint-Boniface Mission Vicariate (Saint-Boniface, Manitoba, Canada)
1865-1870s	Saint-Albert Mission Vicariate (Canada)
1847-1897	St. Paul's Province (Vancouver, Canada)
1923-1999	North Central Province (Minneapolis, Minnesota)
1970-1999	Southern Province (San Antonio, Texas)
1999-present	United States Province (Washington, D.C.)
