| 1859-1897 (closed) | Diocesan priests established and attended St. Francis Solano Mission (Ottawa), Petoskey, from Holy Childhood, Harbor Springs |
| 1879-1881 | Diocesan priests established and attended St. Francis Xavier Mission (Ottawa) from Holy Childhood, Harbor Springs |
| 1881-1884 | Became a parish; diocesan priests administered St. Francis Xavier Church |
| 1884-1897 (no longer Indian) | Franciscans (Sacred Heart Province, St. Louis, Missouri) attended St. Francis Xavier from Holy Childhood, Harbor Springs |
| 1897-present | Franciscans have administered St. Francis Xavier |
| 1927-ca. 1937 (closed) | Franciscans restored St. Francis Solano Mission |

Description: Sacramental records for:

- A. St. Francis Xavier Church and its Indian missions and stations: baptisms, marriages, and deaths, 1881-present; first communions, 1885-present; and confirmations, 1883-present
- B. St. Francis Solanus, Bay Shore: baptisms and deaths, 1902-present; marriages, 1901-present; first communions, 1910-present; and confirmations, 1920-present

Although St. Francis Solanus Mission, Bay Shore was attended from St. Mary's, Charlevoix, 1929-1947, and Holy Childhood, Harbor Springs, 1948-1955, the sacramental records for these years are at St. Francis Xavier Church.
