History: Christ the King Church is a non-Indian parish. However, Christ the King assisted the Siggenauk Center (Menominee, Ojibwa, and other), Milwaukee, which intermittently celebrated and recorded sacraments at Christ the King, 1980-1988 (closed).

1980-1988 (closed) Siggenauk Center (Menominee, Ojibwa, and other), Milwaukee, was established and administered under the auspices of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee with sacraments celebrated and recorded at Christ the King, Holy Spirit, St. Barbara, St. Mathew, and St. Michael Churches
