MUSG TO HOST GUSTER

MILWAUKEE (April 15, 2009) A concert featuring the band Guster, hosted by the Marquette University Student Government Concerts Commission will be on Thursday, April 30 with doors opening at 6:30 p.m. and the performance beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Varsity Theatre.

Tickets are now on sale in the Brooks Lounge on the first floor of the Alumni Memorial Union, and are \$15 with a valid MUID and \$22 for the general public. Those wishing to attend must be 18 or older.

According to the band's website guster.com, Adam Gardner, Ryan Miller, and Brian Rosenworcel formed the alternative rock band in 1991, while attending Tufts University in Massachusetts. The band, which started locally, has received a cult-like following and its music has been featured in shows and films such as *Disturbia*, *Wedding Crashers*, *Life as a House* and *the OC*.

Milwaukee is a stop on the band's Campus Consciousness tour. The tour was created in 2006 by band member Adam Gardner and his wife, environmentalist Lauren Sullivan. Their non-profit organization, Reverb, encourages musicians and their fans to promote environmental sustainability. The tour will feature an interactive "Consciousness Pavilion" on site at each show that will use environmental activities and forums to educate and inspire participants on how to create positive environmental habits.

"I'm pumped that MUSG is bringing Guster to campus! I know a lot of other people really like the band and it's really cool when we get such big names right on campus," Maureen Keane, a junior in the College of Engineering said.
