MUSG TO HOST MU-NOPOLY

After the game, students and their siblings can get their picture taken in a replica of the Monopoly jail cell to commemorate the special night.

Participants will also have the opportunity to challenge each other to interactive games during the night, including an inflatable game called hi-ball, miniature golf and dozens of carnival games. The carnival games include bank shot, skee ball, bucket bonanza, duck pond and many others. From the games, students and little brothers and sisters can win prizes such as Monopoly board games, card games and gifts from the Marquette Spirit Shop.

“It’s bringing Monopoly to life in a sense. It lets students either play with or against their siblings so it is very interactive,” Special Events Commissioner Megan Guilfoyle said. “Also, you get to have your picture taken in a jail cell which is really cool.”
