APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE FOR MUSG PROGRAM BOARD

MILWAUKEE (January 22, 2009)- Applications for the 2009-2010 Marquette University Student Government Program Board are available in the MUSG office, AMU 133, and must be completed and returned by Monday, Feb. 9 at 5 p.m.

The MUSG Program Board, consisting of eight separate commissions, including After Dark, Concerts, Diversity, Excursions, Films, Senior Week, Speakers and Special Events, is responsible for coordinating a majority of the programs and events held within the Marquette community. This board is responsible for providing programming that interests the student body, as the programs are funded through the student activity fee within each student's tuition expenses.

Each respective commissioner is expected to attend bi-weekly Program Board meetings, recruit, train, and supervise his or her individual commission, create and develop at least one program per month, monitor his or her commission's budget, supervise publicity for his or her individual events, maintain at least two office hours per week, and maintain a mandatory 2.00 GPA and be in good standing with the university.

The program board also features a Program Board Assistant who aids in coordinating the various Program Board events and other tasks as needed. The Program Board Assistant receives a stipend and must maintain at least 10 office hours per week and 2.00 GPA.
