**MUSG SENATE ANNOUNCES PROGRESS WITH WELLS STREET MEDIAN AND AMU
COMPUTERS CAMPUS BEAUTIFICATION, SOCIAL NETWORKING DISCUSSED**

MILWAUKEE (Feb. 27, 2009) At its Feb. 26 meeting, the Marquette University Student Government Senate announced significant progress with the construction of the Wells Street median and acquiring more computers for student use in the Alumni Memorial Union.

MUSG President Ray Redlingshafer met with city officials and Rena Altenburg, Marquette University Vice President of Public Affairs, to set up a timeline for the construction of the Wells Street median. Construction is anticipated to start in mid-April, with completion in May. Redlingshafer also announced that Neal Wucherer, Alumni Memorial Union and Auxiliary Service Associate Director, is assisting MUSG in finding a solution to adding computers to the AMU.

"We look forward to working with Mr. Wucherer on this ongoing project and hope to come to a successful conclusion that will work for everyone and really benefit students," Redlingshafer said.

The meeting also included a discussion about the campus planting and beautification process. The beautification project, consisting of planting trees and bushes around the new Well Street median, is scheduled to start at the end of May.
