The Marquette University College of Nursing offers its full-time students several of scholarship opportunities. Most of these scholarships are need-based so a current FAFSA form must be on file in the University Office of Financial Aid in order to be considered for an award or scholarship. Most scholarship decisions are made in the spring of every year for awarding the following year, although some scholarships are awarded throughout the year based on unforeseen financial hardship. To be considered for a scholarship please complete the College of Nursing Scholarship Application Form and forward it to the College of Nursing business manager.

[SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT](#)

Gregory R. Olson Scholarship - The Gregory R. Olson Scholarship is provided to an undergraduate student with unexpected financial need (especially related to changes in health or family circumstances). The student must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or above.

Cecilia Borenitsch Nursing Scholarship - The Cecilia A. Borenitsch Nursing Scholarship is open to undergraduate and graduate nursing students (including direct entry students) with financial need. Students must reside in Milwaukee, Waukesha, Washington, or Ozaukee counties. Students must be enrolled full-time and have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00.

William H. Wasweyler Scholarship - The William H. Wasweyler scholarship is a merit based scholarship provided to residents of Milwaukee, Waukesha, Washington or Ozaukee counties. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Mark A. Cronin, Jr. LaRabida Scholarship - The Mark A Cronin, Jr. La Rabida Scholarship is a partial tuition scholarship given to three nursing students working in externships at La Rabida Hospital. Students must have a 3.0 GPA or higher, be a certified nursing assistant, be committed to working a minimum of 24 – 36 hours per week for nine weeks over the summer,

and have a current CPR card. Preference will be given to residents of the Chicago area, and from a group underrepresented in the nursing profession.

K Fund - The K Fund provides scholarships to full time undergraduate students.

Jane Regan Harris, Class of 1965 Scholarship - The Jane Regan Harris Class of 1965 Scholarship is awarded to students who are interested in studying end of life care.

SCHOLARSHIPS SPECIFIC TO INCOMING FRESHMAN

Ann B. Druml Scholarship - The Ann B. Druml Scholarship is awarded to incoming freshman who are graduates of Divine Holy Angels High School. Students should have a record of academic excellence and a record of community service and leadership. The College of Nursing determines the recipient based on University admission applications.

Florence Brady-Murray Scholarship - The Florence Brady Murray Scholarship is a need based scholarship awarded to incoming students who graduated from a high school from the areas of Fremont, Vickery, Clyde, or Sandusky, Ohio or were born in Ireland.

Nancy Long Pesiri Scholarship (*next award in fall of 2012*) - The Nancy Long Pesiri Scholarship is awarded to incoming freshmen based on a scholarship competition. The four-year award is provided once every four years.

SCHOLARSHIPS SPECIFIC TO JUNIORS

David B. Rowe Memorial Scholarship - The David B. Rowe Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a junior nursing student to be awarded during the senior year. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or higher, have financial need, participate in community service, and intend on working with clients with communicable diseases. Students should submit an application form by October 15. The scholarship decision will be made in early November. The award will be applied to the fall term.

McGrath Scholarship - The McGrath Scholarship is awarded to a junior nursing student to be awarded during the senior year. The student must have a cumulative GPA or 3.0 or better and demonstrate financial need.

SCHOLARSHIPS SPECIFIC TO SENIORS

Mary Catherine Foley Scholarship - The Mary Catherine Foley Scholarship is given to a senior student who overcame great obstacles in order to achieve their college degree. The student must demonstrate financial need as defined by federal standards by the Marquette University Office of Financial Aid. Students should apply for this scholarship during their junior year.
