A class is an organized course offered for credit, identified by discipline and number, meeting at a stated time or times in a classroom or similar setting, and not a subsection such as a laboratory or discussion session. Excluded are distance learning classes, online classes, noncredit classes, individual instruction such as dissertation or thesis research, music instruction, cooperative programs, internships, practicum, independent study, cooperative programs, internships, and one-on-one classes. Each class section is counted only once and is not duplicated because of course catalog cross-listing.

Course level is based on the catalog number of the course.

The class size of cross-listed classes is based on the total enrollment of the cross-listed sections. If a cross-listed class spans multiple course levels, then the section is apportioned based on enrollment so the section is not double-counted.
