Regardless of the subject of the class, student credit hours of classes with section numbers corresponding to the College of Professional Studies have been moved to the College of Professional Studies.

Due to missing data, student credit hours in fall 2005 are based on end-of-term snapshot data, not census snapshot data.

Credit hours of students who have withdrawn prior to the census date and students who are auditing the class have been excluded from student credit hour statistics starting in fall 2006.

The course level is determined by the catalog number of the course. In fall 2009, the university moved to a new course numbering system. The level of a course in the new system may be different from its level in the old system.
