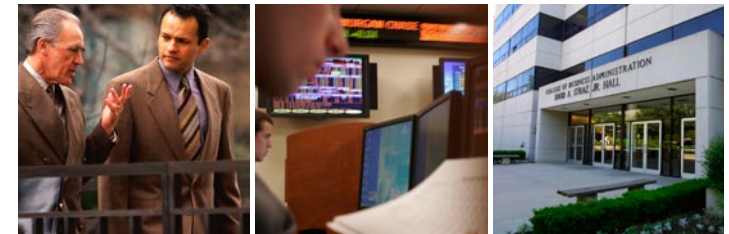

- **Scholarship Golf Outing** (Spring) — The annual outing raises funds for scholarships to students at the College of Business Administration. Since its inception, the outing has raised nearly \$250,000 for student scholarships.
