

## *Faculty Excellence Award*

NRHH recognizes faculty in three ways:

- **Faculty Star Award** recognizes professors who have made an impact on the lives of students living in Marquette residence halls and/or university owned apartments. Any professor who embodies the TEACH paradigm (found on reverse side) is qualified for nomination.
- **Faculty hALL-STAR Award** is awarded to faculty members who have participated in a program(s) in the residence halls and/or university owned apartments and made an impact on the lives of students living in Marquette housing.
- **NRHH Faculty Excellence Award** is the highest honor bestowed upon a professor by residents at Marquette University. The recipient of this award will be chosen for outstanding performance in the classroom and the positive or lasting effect upon lives of students who reside in the residence halls and university apartments. All submissions are considered for this award.

Students, and administrators may nominate professors, or teaching assistants from the 2007-2008 academic year.

All nominators and nominees will be invited to attend the **Faculty Star Award Reception**, to be located in the **Mashuda Ballrooms on Thursday, April 10th at 5pm**. All nominees will receive a certificate recognizing them as a Faculty Star and/or hALL-STAR Award recipient. The Faculty Excellence Award winner will be announced at this reception.
