

## **MARQUETTE UNIVERSITY**

### **Fall 2003 Greek Report**

#### **Membership**

- 371 of Marquette's undergraduates are members of social Greek-letter organizations. This number reflects 5.29% of the campus population. By comparison, this percentage was 5.37% in the Fall of 2002 and 6.9% in Fall of 2001.
- 6.10% of women are Greek – by comparison, this figure was 6.03% in the Fall of 2002 and 6.8% in the Fall of 2001.
- 4.28% of men are Greek – by comparison, this figure was 4.57% in the Fall of 2002 and 7.02% in the Fall of 2001.

#### **Scholarship**

- Five organizations had chapter GPA's above the all-University average (2.99): Alpha Chi Omega, Alpha Xi Delta, Alpha Phi, Sigma Chi and Kappa Sigma
- One of the eighteen chapters has designated funds from their chapter budget to provide scholarships to members with outstanding and/or improved academic achievement. This amount totals \$11,000.
- Nine chapter have also implemented a variety of programs designed to improve scholarship, including study hours, incentive awards, and scholarship recognition events.
- Order of Omega inducted 15 new members into the organization.

#### **Community Service**

- Chapter service projects resulted in a total of 1708.5 hours of hands-on service to neighborhood and community agencies. This number does not include individual service performed by members or hours spent raising money through philanthropic activities.
- In addition, seven of the fifteen Greek chapter raised \$4411.84 for donations to local and national charities this semester.
- Included in the above numbers and worthy of individual recognition, the women of Alpha Phi who donated nearly 122.5 hours in efforts and raised \$1670.00.
- The Interfraternity Council and the Panhellenic Association co-sponsored an all Greek Service Event and 225 students from the Greek community assisted in the cleaning up of a local Milwaukee neighborhood.

#### **Campus Involvement**

- 70.8% of Greek members reported involvement in other campus organizations and 30.4% serve in campus leadership roles. In comparison to the Fall 2002, 64% of Greek students were involved in other student organizations and only 17% held major leadership roles on campus.

#### **Education**

- Chapter officers implemented approximately 50 educational programs for their members on topics including ritual, sexual assault awareness, alcohol awareness, leadership retreats, membership intake, resume building and study skills. In addition, a number of chapters presented programs for the broader campus community.

#### **Discipline**

- The IFC and Panhellenic Association Joint Judicial Board Chairs continued to work to educate the Social Chairs and Risk Management chairs of each chapter on the Greek community's risk reduction policy. In the Fall 2003 semester a total of 9 Greek Judicial Board cases were heard.
- The Sigma Phi Epsilon chapter was placed on probation for 6 months due to violations of the risk management policy and allegations.
