

## **Fall 2001 Greek Report**

### **Membership**

- 461 of Marquette's undergraduates are members of social Greek-letter organizations. This number reflects 6.9% of the campus population. By comparison, this percentage was 6.8% in the fall of 2000 and 6.9% in the fall of 1999.
- 6.8% of women are Greek – by comparison, this figure was 7.0% at this time last year and 6.7% two years ago.
- 7.0% of men are Greek – by comparison, this figure was 6.5% at this time last year and 7.1% two years ago.

### **Scholarship**

- Two organizations had chapter GPA's above the all-University average (2.94): Alpha Xi Delta and Alpha Chi Omega.
- Sigma Phi Delta, a chapter of predominantly engineering majors, had a chapter GPA (2.74) above the all-College GPA for the College of Engineering (2.69).
- Seven of our seventeen chapters have designated funds from their chapter budget to provide scholarships to members with outstanding and/or improved academic achievement.
- Ten chapters have also implemented a variety of programs designed to improve scholarship, including study hours, incentive awards, and scholarship recognition events.

### **Community Service**

- Chapter service projects resulted in a total of 1,239 hours of service to neighborhood and community agencies. This number does not include individual service performed by members or hours spent raising money through philanthropic activities.
- In addition, a total of \$8,496 was raised and donated to local and national charities this semester. This is a dramatic increase from last semester's \$3,570.

### **Campus Involvement**

- 57% of Greek members reported involvement in other campus organizations and 22% serve in campus leadership roles.
- Members of Greek organizations serve in a variety of leadership positions on campus, including student organization presidents, MUSG Senators, Midnight Run Coordinator, Winter Flurry Planning Team members, Orientation Director and Planning Team members, AMU Student Managers, Hall Council leaders, Ministry Retreat Leaders, and Resident Advisors, among others.

### **Education**

- Chapter officers implemented more than 15 educational programs for their membership on topics including time management, anti-hazing, study skills, career development, alcohol abuse, and sexual assault. In addition, a number of chapters presented programs for the broader campus community.
- Alpha Chi Omega, with support from a number of other chapters, sponsored *Kristin's Story* in November. This all-campus event was an excellent opportunity for students and staff to learn about date rape and suicide from a mother's perspective.
- Members of Sigma Lambda Beta attended the US Hispanic Leadership Conference in September.

### **Discipline**

- The Joint Judicial Board heard one case involving the violation of the IFC/Panhellenic Risk Reduction Policy. Delta Chi was found not responsible for all charges.
