

Spring 2002 Greek Report

Membership

- 485 of Marquette's undergraduates are members of social Greek-letter organizations. This number reflects 7.4% of the campus population. By comparison, this percentage was 8.7% in the spring of 2001 and 8.1% in the spring of 2000.
- 7.7% of women are Greek – by comparison, this figure was 8.7% at this time last year and 8.2% two years ago.
- 7.2% of men are Greek – by comparison, this figure was 8.8% at this time last year and 8.0% two years ago.

Scholarship

- Three organizations had chapter GPA's above the all-University average (2.95): Phi Beta Sigma, Alpha Chi Omega and Alpha Xi Delta.
- Four of our sixteen chapters have designated funds from their chapter budget to provide scholarships to members with outstanding and/or improved academic achievement.
- Ten chapters have also implemented a variety of programs designed to improve scholarship, including study hours, incentive awards, and scholarship recognition events.

Community Service

- Chapter service projects resulted in a total of 1,781 hours of hands-on service to neighborhood and community agencies. Over the course of the 2001-2002 academic year a total of 3,020 hours of service were performed through group service projects by Greek chapters. This represents an increase of nearly 300 hours from the 2000-2001 academic year. These numbers do not include individual service performed by members or hours spent raising money through philanthropic activities.
- In addition, 629 hours were spent raising \$5,720 for donations to local and national charities this semester. Overall \$14,261 was raised during the 2001-2002 academic year by Marquette's fraternities and sororities. This is nearly double the funds raised during the 2000-2001 year.
- Included in the above numbers but worthy of individual recognition, the women of Alpha Phi donated nearly 500 hours in efforts to raise \$2,600 for the Alpha Phi Foundation, their national philanthropy.

Campus Involvement

- 63% of Greek members reported involvement in other campus organizations and 19% serve in campus leadership roles.
- Members of Greek organizations serve in a variety of leadership positions on campus, including officers of other student organizations, orientation planning team members, Resident Assistants, Winter Flurry planning team members, LEAD Center staff, Student Government representatives, and many more.

Education

- Chapter officers implemented approximately 15 educational programs for their members on topics including breast cancer awareness, sexual assault awareness, alcohol awareness, and a focus on living the values of their organization. In addition, a number of chapters presented programs for the broader campus community.

Discipline

- The IFC and Panhellenic Council Joint Judicial Board Chairs worked diligently this semester to clarify and raise accountability for paperwork required of chapters hosting social events. A new procedure was established with input from chapter presidents, governing councils and chapter advisors. Individual meetings with social chairs and presidents were held to provide one-on-one education about the risk management requirements and procedures.

Greek Awards 2002

- A number of individuals and chapters were honored for their contributions to Greek life at Marquette during the annual Greek Awards in April. Honorees included:
