REQUIREMENTS AND DEADLINES

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

All of the following credentials must be received by the Physician Assistant Studies Program by **November 1**:

- 1. Submission of a completed Central Application Service for Physician Assistants at www.caspaonline.org
- 2. Submission of this completed Supplemental Application form to the Marquette Physician Assistants Studies Program
- 3. Official copy of GRE scores directly to Marquette Physician Assistants Studies Program, for applicants who will have a Bachelor's Degree at the time of enrollment
- 4. \$55 application fee (non-refundable)
- 5. ACT and/or SAT scores (for applicants who have not earned an undergraduate degree)
- 6. Attach supplemental narrative for Marquette University

FINANCIAL AID APPLICANTS

If you wish to apply for need-based financial assistance (grants, loans and employment), YOU MUST:

1. Apply for admission, using the attached application form and the online CASPA application
2. Provide your social security number in the appropriate space on this application form
3. File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid online at www.fafsa.ed.gov

The FAFSA form must be submitted on an annual basis as soon after **January 1** as possible. (Although it is NOT necessary to complete your income tax forms before filing the FAFSA, we recommend that you report income figures as accurately and completely as possible.)
