PRE-COLLEGE PROGRAM IN SPORTS MEDICINE**

For fourteen years Marquette University has offered a successful program for minority and disadvantaged students in the Milwaukee area to learn about physical therapy. Eight minority or disadvantaged students will be chosen from an application and interview process. The selected students must meet the following qualifications:

- Be a disadvantaged student (financially and/or educationally disadvantaged, e.g. first generation college student, qualifying for federal hot lunch program, or from an urban school setting)
- High school senior in the fall semester. High school sophomores and juniors will be considered for the fall and spring program.
- At least a 2.7 cumulative grade point average.
- Interested in a health science career.
- Planning on attending college.

If you are interested in physical therapy, sports medicine, athletic training, and/or exercise science this is the opportunity for you! Each student will spend approximately 3 hours a week, after school at Marquette. The days and times are flexible and can accommodate other extracurricular activities. The entire program will last 8 weeks. A Marquette University physical therapy student will mentor you. High school students will learn about the fields of physical therapy, including sports rehabilitation.

You will be able to tour Marquette University's campus and attend different activities. Your experience with us will end with a reception for you, your parents, Marquette faculty and your student mentor. After you complete this program, you will receive a \$100 scholarship and a certificate of participation. This is an excellent opportunity for students who have an interest in a health care field! It will be to your benefit to participate, especially if you plan on applying to a health science program.

Please have your application in by January 15 of the current year for spring enrollment and by August 1 of current year for fall enrollment for this exciting opportunity!
