Marquette University Academic Policy: Undergraduate Residency

Effective for students starting Fall 2010

Residency is defined as the number of courses/credits which a student must earn at an institution in order to be awarded a degree from that institution. The following policy applies to all undergraduate students, with the exception of those who are admitted to the College of Professional Studies.

- 1. **Total Credits:** A minimum of 60 Marquette credits are required to earn an undergraduate degree.
- 2. **Final Credits:** The final 30 credits needed to complete an undergraduate degree must be Marquette credits or in an OIE approved study abroad program.
- 3. **Upper Division Credits:** A minimum of 32 Upper Division Marquette credits are required to earn a Marquette undergraduate degree.
- 4. **Major Credits:** A minimum of 15 Marquette credits in the major are required to earn a Marquette undergraduate degree.
- 5. Exceptions to this policy will be approved by the Office of the Provost.

Academic Policy: College of Professional Studies Undergraduate Residency

Effective for students starting Fall 2010

- **1. Total Credits:** A minimum of 45 Marquette credits are required to earn an undergraduate degree from the College of Professional Studies.
- **2. Final Credits:** The final 30 credits needed to complete an undergraduate degree must be Marquette credits or in an OIE approved study abroad program.
- **3. Upper Division Credits:** A minimum of 32 Upper Division Marquette credits are required to earn a Marquette undergraduate degree.
- **4. Major Credits:** A minimum of 15 Marquette credits in the major are required to earn a Marquette undergraduate degree.
- **5.** Exceptions to this policy will be approved by the Office of the Provost.
