#### ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

1. Abstracts must be typed, single-spaced, using Arial font size 12, on one 8½" by 11" sheet of paper with a 1½" margin on the left and 1" margins on all other sides.
2. The heading must include the title of the paper/poster in CAPITAL LETTERS, the authors' names (with given names first and surnames last) and credentials, and the principal investigator's organizational affiliation, city, phone number and e-mail.
3. At the top of your abstract indicate if you want your submission considered for a paper, poster or both. Also, please indicate the most relevant topic area as described above.
4. Abstracts must include the following:

A. Title and objective	E. Sample description/population	H. Results/outcomes (if applicable)
B. Purpose of the study/project	F. Setting	I. Conclusions/implications
C. Framework, if applicable	G. Method/design and procedure	J. Description of team
D. Background and significance		

**Priority will be give to interdisciplinary projects.**
