Program Costs

For students entering the program in the 2011-12 academic year, the cost of tuition will be \$945 per credit hour. Students must complete 84 credit hours for completion of the Ph.D. For each of the last five years, each and every doctoral student entering with a bachelor's degree (versus those entering with MS degrees) received a full graduate assistantship, which included full tuition and a stipend that presently amounts to \$14,750 for the academic year, their first two years, and approximately three-fourths of a graduate assistantship their third year. Most students obtain psychology-related work (e.g., working for a psychologist administering tests) or teach (for the department or for colleges in the area) after their third year.
