The Marquette University Student Health Service medical excuse policy is consistent with the recommendations of the American College Health Association and supports our commitment to student privacy. The student health service **will not provide** medical excuses for missed classes, exams, or assignments. We suggest that you as a faculty member dialogue with the student regarding their circumstances for missing class or missed assignments.

Our policy is similar to other major universities and is endorsed by the Office of the Provost. It is respectful of students and their responsibilities, encourages a shared code of values and promotes trust among students and faculty, and avoids inconvenience for the students allowing them to devote more time to their studies.
